

Beverley Blues Weekend



This year, the 26th to the 28th of October, will be **Beverley Blues Weekends** 8th annual Event and this year will be focusing heavily on local blues artists and bands not normally seen together over one weekend.

The headline act this year will be **Half Deaf Clatch** aka Andrew McClatchie from Hull. He has, to great acclaim, released almost 2 dozen albums over recent years and has been a finalist in the UK Blues Awards 11 times for Acoustic Blues Act, Blues Songwriter and Innovation in the blues.

He describes himself as a 'slide stomp, growl machine' and plays a crossover style of Delta and Hill Country Blues with a macabre alternative edge. (www.halfdeafclatch.com)

He is supported by **Chris Martin** who has been described as one of Yorkshires prominent slide players who delivers a delicate and unique style to the blues.
